MANASSEH IS THE PRODIGAL SON OF THE OLD TESTAMENT.

- His father was King Hezekiah.
- Co-regents for 10 years.
- Death of his father impacted him in some way.
- Grief can have a powerful effect on us.
- Grief is <u>a sacred expression of our love</u> for someone we've lost.

MANASSEH REBELS AGAINST GOD

² He did what was evil in the Lord's sight, following the detestable practices of the pagan nations that the Lord had driven from the land ahead of the Israelites. ³ He rebuilt the pagan shrines his father, Hezekiah, had broken down. He constructed altars for the images of Baal and set up Asherah poles. He also bowed before all the powers of the heavens and worshiped them. ⁴ He built pagan altars in the Temple of the Lord, the place where the Lord had said, "My name will remain in Jerusalem forever." ⁵ He built these altars for all the powers of the heavens in both courtvards of the Lord's Temple.

⁶ Manasseh also sacrificed his own sons in the fire in the valley

of Ben-Hinnom. He practiced sorcery, divination, and witchcraft, and he consulted with mediums and psychics. He did much that was evil in the Lord's sight, arousing his anger. **2 Chronicles 33:2-6 NLT**

- All sin is against God.

HOW FAR IS TOO FAR?

- No matter what you have done, you have not out-sinned God's ability to forgive you.

MANASSEH REPENTS!

¹⁰ The Lord spoke to Manasseh and his people, but they ignored all his warnings. ¹¹ So the Lord sent the commanders of the Assyrian armies, and they took Manasseh prisoner. They put a ring through his nose, bound him in bronze chains, and led him away to Babylon. ¹² But while in deep distress, Manasseh sought the Lord his God and sincerely humbled himself before the God of his ancestors. ¹³ And when he prayed, the Lord listened to him and was moved by his request. So the Lord brought Manasseh back to Jerusalem and to his kingdom. Then Manasseh finally realized that the Lord alone is God! **2**

¹⁴ After this Manasseh rebuilt the outer wall of the City of David, from west of the Gihon Spring in the Kidron Valley to the Fish Gate, and continuing around the hill of Ophel. He built the wall very high. And he stationed his military officers in all of the fortified towns of Judah. ¹⁵ Manasseh also removed the foreign gods and the idol from the Lord's Temple. He tore down all the altars he had built on the hill where the Temple stood and all the altars that were in Jerusalem, and he dumped them outside the city. ¹⁶ Then he restored the altar of the Lord and sacrificed peace offerings and thanksgiving offerings on it. He also encouraged the people of Judah to worship the Lord, the God of Israel. 2 Chronicles 33:14-16 NLT
