

The Reason for Joy

Paul later wrote to the church in Philippi, <u>from prison</u>, to thank them for the gift they had sent and to encourage them in their faith.

Joy - the emotion evoked by the prospect or <u>anticipation</u> of possessing what one desires.

Joy is a choice!

...fixing our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of faith, who for the joy set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God. **Hebrews 12:2 NASB 95**

¹⁷ Those others do not have pure motives as they preach about Christ. They preach with selfish ambition, not sincerely, intending to make my chains more painful to me. ¹⁸ But that doesn't matter.
