### WHAT IS YOUR PSALM?

Psalms are composed of sacred songs, or of sacred poems meant to be sung.

Psalms were written with a general structure:

# ADDRESS - A CALL OUT TO GOD.

<sup>1</sup> Shout with joy to the Lord, all the earth! <sup>2</sup> Worship the Lord with gladness. Come before him, singing with joy. <sup>3</sup> Acknowledge that the Lord is God! He made us, and we are his. We are his people, the sheep of his pasture. **Psalm 100:1-3 NLT** 

<sup>1</sup> I cry out to God; yes, I shout. Oh, that God would listen to me! **Psalm 77:1 NLT** 

<sup>1</sup> I cry out to the Lord; I plead for the Lord's mercy. <sup>2</sup> I pour out my complaints before him and tell him all my troubles. **Psalm 142:1-2 NLT** 

### DISTRESS - THE PROBLEM OR CRISIS YOU ARE FACING.

<sup>3</sup> When I am overwhelmed, you alone know the way I should turn. Wherever I go, my enemies have set traps for me. **Psalm 142:3 NLT** 

<sup>2</sup> But as for me, I almost lost my footing. My feet were slipping, and I was almost gone. <sup>3</sup> For I envied the proud when I saw them prosper despite their wickedness. **Psalm 73:2-3 NLT** 

<sup>9</sup> Have mercy on me, LORD, for I am in distress. Tears blur my eyes. My body and souls are withering away. <sup>10</sup> I am dying from grief; my years are shortened by sadness. Sin has drained my strength; I am wasting away from within. **Psalm 31:9-10 NLT** 

APPEAL - TELLING GOD WHAT YOU NEED.

<sup>4</sup> The one thing I ask of the Lord – the thing I seek the most – is to live in the house of the LORD all the days of my life, delighting in the LORD's perfections and meditating in his Temple. **Psalm 27:4 NLT** 

<sup>1</sup> O God, do not be silent! Do not be deaf. Do not be quiet, O God. **Psalm 83:1 NLT** 

<sup>16</sup> So I tried to understand why the wicked prosper. But what a difficult task it is! **Psalm 73:16 NLT** 

# DELIVERANCE - HOW GOD HELPED YOU.

<sup>17</sup> Then I went into your sanctuary, O God, and I finally understood the destiny of the wicked. **Psalm 73:17 NLT** 

<sup>17</sup> The LORD hears his people when they call to him for help. He rescues them from all their troubles. <sup>18</sup> The LORD is close to the brokenhearted; he rescues those whose spirits are crushed. **Psalm 34:17-18 NLT** 

<sup>7</sup> We escaped like a bird from a hunter's trap. The trap is broken, and we are free! **Psalm 124:7 NLT** 

# TESTIMONY – ACKNOWLEDGMENT AND PRAISE FOR GOD'S HELP.

<sup>8</sup> Our help is from the LORD, who made heaven and earth. Psalm 124:8 NLT

<sup>23</sup> Yet I still belong to you; you hold my right hand. <sup>24</sup> You guide me with your counsel, leading me to a glorious destiny. **Psalm 73:23-24 NLT** 

<sup>17</sup> O my Strength, to you I sing praises, for you, O God, are my refuge, the God who shows me unfailing love. **Psalm 59:17 NLT**
