UNCOVERING THE TRUTH ABOUT OUR BELIEFS

Beliefs—Accept (something) as true; feel sure of the truth of; hold (something) as an opinion; think or suppose.

³¹ Then Jesus said to those Jews <u>who believed</u> Him, "If you abide in My word, <u>you are My disciples indeed</u>. ³² And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free." **John 8:31-32 NKJV**

"Truth without grace is legalism. Grace without truth is deception. But truth with grace is transformation."

- Truth is not just information—it is transformation.
- Knowing the truth brings freedom, not restriction.

Point 1:

Genesis 3:1-5—The First Lie: The serpent deceived Eve by making her question God's word.

The Devil's Strategy: John 8:44—When he speaks a lie, he speaks from his own resources, for he is a liar and the father of it.

• A lie believed as truth will affect your life as if it were true.

Point 2:

John 8:32— "You shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free."

- Truth transforms our identity and decisions.
- Truth is not just about knowing facts—it's about experiencing freedom.

Point 3:

Psalm 119:105— "Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path."

- Truth is a foundation for life.
 - o If we build on feelings or cultural opinions, we will be unstable.

1. Gathering the Ingredients—The Individual Parts of Our Lives

- Eggs (Hard situations)
- Flour (Dry seasons)
- Sugar (Sweet blessings)
- Butter (Things that seem messy)

2. Mixing the Ingredients—The Uncomfortable Process
