# **TRUSTING GOD**

#### DO I REALLY TRUST GOD?

- Most of us would say "I want to trust God."
- Some might say "God has let me down."

<sup>1</sup> One day as Jesus was preaching on the shore of the Sea of Galilee, great crowds pressed in on him to listen to the word of God. <sup>2</sup> He noticed two empty boats at the water's edge, for the fishermen had left them and were washing their nets. <sup>3</sup> Stepping into one of the boats, Jesus asked Simon, its owner, to push it out into the water. So he sat in the boat and taught the crowds from there. <sup>4</sup> When he had finished speaking, he said to Simon, "Now go out where it is deeper, and let down your nets to catch some fish." <sup>5</sup> "Master," Simon replied, "we worked hard all last night and didn't catch a thing. But if you say so, I'll let the nets down again." <sup>6</sup> And this time their nets were so full of fish they began to tear! <sup>7</sup> A shout for help brought their partners in the other boat, and soon both boats were filled with fish and on the verge of sinking. <sup>8</sup> When Simon Peter realized what had happened, he fell to his knees before Jesus and said, "Oh, Lord, please leave me—I'm such a sinful man." <sup>9</sup> For he was awestruck by the number of fish they had caught, as were the others with him. <sup>10</sup> His partners, James and John, the sons of Zebedee, were also amazed. Jesus replied to Simon, "Don't be afraid! From now on you'll be fishing for people!" <sup>11</sup> And as soon as they landed, they left everything and followed Jesus. Luke 5:1-11 NLT

### GOD HELP ME TO TRUST YOU WHEN I'M WEARY.

<sup>5a</sup> "Master," Simon replied, "we worked hard all last night and didn't catch a thing." Luke 5:5a NLT

<sup>28</sup> Then Jesus said, "Come to me, all of you who are weary and carry heavy burdens, and I will give you rest. <sup>29</sup> Take my yoke upon you. Let me teach you, because I am humble and gentle at heart, and you will find rest for your souls. <sup>30</sup> For my yoke is easy to bear, and the burden I give you is light." Matthew 11:28-30 NLT

#### GOD HELP ME TO TRUST YOU WHEN IT DOESN'T MAKE SENSE.

- Faith and fear are polar opposites.
- If your trust and faith in the Lord is high, your fear and worry level will be low.

## YOU DON'T HAVE TO <u>UNDERSTAND COMPLETELY</u>, TO <u>TRUST GOD</u> <u>COMPLETELY</u>.

- The outcome is God's responsibility—<u>Obedience is yours</u>.

## LORD HELP ME TO OBEY EVEN WHEN I DON'T UNDERSTAND.

<sup>5</sup> Trust in the Lord with all your heart; do not depend on your own understanding. <sup>6</sup> Seek his will in all you do, and he will show you which path to take. **Proverbs 3:5-6 NLT** 

<sup>7</sup> Some trust in chariots and some in horses, but we trust in the name of the Lord our God. **Psalm 20:7 NIV** 

## THEY LEFT EVERYTHING AND FOLLOWED JESUS.

<sup>10b</sup> Jesus replied to Simon, "Don't be afraid! From now on you'll be fishing for people!" <sup>11</sup> And as soon as they landed, **they left everything** and followed Jesus. **Luke 5:10b-11 NLT** 

- They trusted Jesus with everything.
- They surrendered what they had always done for something better.
