## **Unity** ≠ <u>**Uniformity**</u>

The things that we are most passionate about often cause <u>harm</u> to the things in our life that matter most.

<sup>20</sup> "I am praying not only for these disciples but also for all who will ever believe in me through their message. <sup>21</sup> I pray that they will all be one, just as you and I are one—as you are in me, Father, and I am in you. And may they be in us so that the world will believe you sent me. <sup>22</sup> "I have given them the glory you gave me, so they may be one as we are one. <sup>23</sup> I am in them and you are in me. <sup>1</sup> What causes quarrels and what causes fights among you? Is it not this, that your passions are at war within you? **James 4:1 ESV** 

#### Choose to focus on what unites us.

- Our Savior
- <sup>6</sup> Jesus told him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one can come to the Father except through me." **John 14:6 NLT** 
  - Our Enemy
- <sup>8</sup> Stay alert! Watch out for your great enemy, the devil. He prowls around like a roaring lion, looking for someone to devour. 1 Peter 5:8 NLT
- <sup>12</sup> A person standing alone can be attacked and defeated, but two can stand back-to-back and conquer. Three are even better, for a triple-braided cord is not easily broken. **Ecclesiastes 4:12 NLT**

Our Mission

<sup>19</sup> Therefore, go and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. <sup>20</sup> Teach these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you. And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age. **Matthew 28:19-20 NLT**

### Choose to handle conflict in a biblical manner.

With the individual(s)

<sup>15</sup> "If another believer sins against you, go privately and point out the offense. If the other person listens and confesses it, you have won that person back." Matthew 18:15 NLT

- <sup>23</sup> "So if you are presenting a sacrifice at the altar in the Temple and you suddenly remember that someone has something against you, <sup>24</sup> leave your sacrifice there at the altar. Go and be reconciled to that person. Then come and offer your sacrifice to God." **Matthew 5:23-24 NLT** 
  - Without competition
- <sup>3</sup> Don't be selfish; don't try to impress others. Be humble, thinking of others as better than yourselves. <sup>4</sup> Don't look out only for your own interests, but take an interest in others, too. **Philippians 2:3-4 NLT** 
  - With Christlikeness
- <sup>5</sup> You must have the same attitude that Christ Jesus had. <sup>6</sup> Though he was God, he did not think of equality with God as something to cling to. <sup>7</sup> Instead, he gave up his divine privileges; he took the humble position of a slave and was born as a human being. When he appeared in human form, <sup>8</sup> he humbled himself in obedience to God and died a criminal's death on a cross. **Philippians 2:5-8 NLT**
