 Life trends toward <u>order</u> when God is first and toward <u>chaos</u> when He is not.

¹ Then the Lord said to Moses, ² "Dedicate to me every firstborn among the Israelites. The first offspring to be born, of both humans and animals, belongs to me."... ¹² "you must present all firstborn sons and firstborn male animals to the Lord, for they belong to him. ¹³ A firstborn donkey may be bought back from the Lord by presenting a lamb or young goat in its place. But if you do not buy it back, you must break its neck. However, you must buy back every firstborn son." **Exodus 13:1-2, 12-13 NLT**

We give our <u>first</u> and <u>best</u> to God because He gave his first and best for us.

- Pada To buy out, redeem, ransom, or <u>release</u>.
- Tithing is the only thing God invites you to test him on.

³ In the course of time Cain brought to the Lord an offering of the fruit of the ground, ⁴ and Abel also brought of the firstborn of his flock and of their fat portions. And the Lord had regard for Abel and his offering, ⁵ but for Cain and his offering he had no regard... **Genesis 4:3-5 ESV**

• What belongs to God is sacred and not to be used for <u>common things</u>.

Wherever your treasure is, there the desires of your heart will also be. Matthew 6:21 NLT

You will never be able to <u>afford</u> to tithe <u>until</u> you tithe.

Remember this: Whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows generously will also reap generously. **2 Corinthians 9:6 NIV**

¹³ "And in the future, your children will ask you, 'What does all this mean?' That is why I now sacrifice all the firstborn males to the Lord - except that the firstborn sons are always bought back.'" Exodus 13:14-15 NLT
