Paige Humphreys and her family have been attending Journey since 2017. While their family has always loved Journey and taken message series to heart, one in particular had a major impact on Paige and her family. "Pastor Mike's series, "Ducks In A Row," really hit me to the core. It all started in 2021 when I was blessed and had the privilege to help lead my son (Deacon) to Christ and walk him through the prayer of salvation. He was 6 years old at the time."

Deacon had been asking about baptism, but since he was only 6 years old at the time, it was hard for Paige to know if she should let him be baptized. Did he fully understand what it symbolized and really meant?

As time passed, Deacon would ask every so often if he could be baptized, and they put it off because it required planning. "Sometimes I look at our schedules and all I can think of is how I can possibly fit in reading the Bible every day or commit to serving. It feels hard, and I don't want to commit only to end up failing." But then Paige realized the truth: making room for spiritual growth and discipleship was going to positively affect her family more than any other tasks on her to-do list! After realizing they needed to make their family's spiritual growth a top priority, they made some changes!

"I decided to simply put a family devotional book in the middle of our table and started reading it together during family meals. Something simple like that felt so good!"

During our sermon series, "Ducks in a Row," when Pastor Mike asked, "Who is YOUR one?," the Holy Spirit spoke to Paige immediately. "It was like an arrow to the heart. In that moment, the Holy Spirit reminded me that Deacon's relationship is with Him. And Deacon's heart and intentions are not meant for me to control. I'm his mom, he was my one and all we needed to do was CELEBRATE that Deacon's life had been CHANGED FOREVER! It is my job and responsibility to help him in his walk with Christ."

Deacon is now scheduled to be baptized at Journey during our Celebrate the Miracles Baptism Celebration!

Amy and Bo Burbarge began attending Journey after a friend invited them to church. They were moving back to the area and decided to give Journey a try. "We loved it! Pastor Mike preaches on everyday things that everyday people go through in life. We could really relate. I also loved the worship music." Amy later began serving in the cafe and joined a Journey Life Group. "Because of shift work, it was really hard for Bo to get connected." But Bo wasn't satisfied with just coming to church. "Bo has always been the spiritual leader of our family! He really wanted us to step up as a family, be more involved at Journey, take more ownership, and be leaders for our church family." Bo and Amy began serving together on the Greeter Dream Team and later found a Life Group that worked with their crazy schedules. "I've always loved hosting gatherings at my home and love to feed people."

Being a part of the Journey Dream Team and a Life Group served to be a lifeline when the real world hit. "My mother passed away in January, and my father was also having health issues. Our Dream Team and Life Group really stepped up and were there for me during this hard time. They prayed for us, called daily, and provided meals. If we hadn't been involved, I don't think anyone would have known what we were going through at that time. These people have shown us so much love and compassion this year as we have had a few struggles in life."

On October 30, a fire destroyed the shop Bo had spent so much time and hard work building over the past several months. A lot of "things" were lost, but Amy and Bo cling to 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18.

"Always be joyful. Never stop praying. Be thankful in all circumstances, for this is God's will for you who belong to Christ Jesus."

They said, "Knowing that our Life Group and Dream Team were praying for us, offering meals, helping with clean up, made all the difference! You can come to church, hear the message, and leave. And, that's what we did for some time. But you will also never feel connected or really grow in your walk with Christ. However serving with others and being a part of a Life Group made an everlasting change in our lives. We have grown in our marriage, our relationship with God, and our relationships with other believers. We are far from perfect, but strive to be the disciples Pastor Mike often speaks of on Sunday morning."

At the age of 16, Betty Townsend visited church for the first time with her aunt. "My mother and I had a strained relationship, so I would spend a lot of time with my aunt. Betty had thought about Life Groups in the past, but the time hadn't been right. However, she knew the love and support from a Life Group was just what she needed at this time!

Betty has branched out and grown in her relationship with God over the last year and has also joined the monthly Prayer Gatherings. "I have found that when you're at your lowest, the best thing you can do is to help others." Being a part of the monthly Prayer Gatherings has given Betty the chance to not only serve others at Journey but to pray for those who have yet to walk through our church doors.

Six years ago, God gave Pastor Patrick Franklin the vision for Village Church. At the time, it was unimaginable to him how God would end up blessing and moving through this church plant. Because of your faithful giving, Village Church has created a place where people can belong, find a Christian community, and experience the life-change that only Jesus Christ can bring. Over the first 4 months, they have seen growth in many areas. Since launching on August 20, 2023, weekly worship attendance has averaged 115! Over 40% of those attendees have joined as members. Outreach events have helped attendees to grow from consumers to contributors. They've started Sunday morning ministries for children and pre-teens, and a Wednesday night service for teenagers. The most important growth they've seen is lost souls receiving salvation! On November 12, they baptized 9 people!

In 2024, they plan to launch in-home small groups for adults. They are already vision-casting the purchase of land and building their own facility. Pastor Patrick Franklin and his team want to continue to multiply ministry and know that having their own building will help accomplish all that God has planned for His church. Recently, they established their headquarters in a central location in the city where they will hold all of their midweek events. It has been amazing to see what God has done so far and know that He is just getting started using YOUR Church. MINISTIPICS ZAMBIA, AFRICA

Meet Derek and Madi McAtee! This year, their work in Zambia through Overland Ministries has doubled! They have gone from ministering in 3 villages to 6, they have gone from 7 ministry partners to 13, and they conducted a leadership conference for 200 people when last year it was only 100. They even had 3 motorbikes donated to help cover more ground. The number of people desiring to be active in ministry has more than quadrupled! The McAtees are seeing salvations flood in from farming conferences, house-to-house ministry, revival nights, and small group meetings.

Next year, they hope to expand by acquiring property in the chiefdom in order to build a launching point for their full-time ministry partners. The strategic location of this base will enable them to be even more effective in their community ministry, causing relationships with the community to grow exponentially. Derek, Madi, and their ministry partners aren't out to simply make converts, but true disciples! The more they pour into a few through deep discipleship, the farther and faster they go and multiply Christ in the region. They aren't in Zambia to make their names or faces known, but to make the name of Jesus known and grow His Kingdom through making disciples!

Family Home & Parenting (FHP) exists to present the light of Jesus Christ to those struggling with addiction and other life-controlling issues, along with their families, and to enable freedom in Christ by teaching them the skills necessary for a thriving, Christ-centered family. This ministry brings the gospel into local county jails and provides transitional assistance for men and women coming out of incarceration. FHP walks alongside them on a journey of reconciliation with God and their families. As part of this ministry, FHP operates The DUGOUT residential recovery and discipleship home for men, which combines a structured living environment with Celebrate Recovery and discipleship curriculum.

In the last year, your contributions helped distribute nearly 400 copies of the Celebrate Recovery Bible in local jails. Along with over 300 Celebrate Recovery study guides, these resources facilitated sharing the gospel with over 1,000 inmates from our local area and assisted in the transitional housing, employment, and spiritual needs of over 100 individuals. Fifteen men were directly discipled through The DUGOUT residential home.

In 2024, FHP plans to expand in both Elmore and Autauga County jails by starting a women's outreach ministry, launching a men's discipleship program in Staton Correctional Facility, and opening a women's residential recovery home in the local area. Thank you for giving to generationally impact families in our community!
