1. In light of the beatitudes, how is Jesus's idea of being "blessed" different from what the world says it means to be happy or successful?
2. Share a time when you felt "poor in spirit"—realizing you could not depend on yourself, and desperately needed God's help?
3. What does it look like to "mourn over sin" in your own life or in the world around you, and how can you show that you care about what breaks God's heart?
4. IN what kind of life circumstances do you find it hard to be meek or gentle?
5. Discuss a time when you felt God comforting you through a serious hardship.
6. What does it look like to have a "pure heart" in today's world?
7. Who in your life has shown you mercy or forgiveness, and how did it affect you?
8. How do you think your life would look different if you truly believed being "blessed" means having God's approval, not just being happy or popular?
9. How can remembering that God approves of you help you keep going when you face challenges or feel left out?
