



Sermon-based Discussions | Kingdom Values Wk 3 | Mind of Christ vs Ways of the World

1. **Heart Check:** Discuss an area of your life that you felt convicted and compelled to let the Holy Spirit address and correct your inner motives.
2. **Anger and Reconciliation:** Reflect on a time when you justified holding onto anger or a grudge. What kept (or keeps) you from pursuing reconciliation—even when you believe you are not at fault?
3. **Purity of Mind:** How do you guard your thoughts and intentions in a culture that normalizes or celebrates all kinds of immorality? What practical steps can you take to see others as God's beloved, rather than as objects?
4. **Commitment in Relationships:** Relationships can be hard. When commitment becomes difficult, do you tend to view relationships as contracts or covenants (joined by God)? What does faithfulness look like?
5. **Integrity and Truthfulness:** Can you recall and discuss any situation in your life where you were tempted to use a half-truth, loophole, or empty promise to satisfy someone's expectations? What do you think some people struggle with that?
6. **Radical Forgiveness:** When wronged, is your first instinct to demand your rights or to extend mercy? What would it look like for you to go the "extra mile" or "turn the other cheek" in a situation you're facing now?
7. **Loving Enemies:** Who is someone you struggle to love or even pray for? What might change in your heart or actions if you viewed them as God's dearly loved child?



8. **Love in Action:** Looking at the traits of “love” in 1 Corinthians 13 (below), name one trait you feel that you live out well, and one you find most difficult to live out?

Love is patient and kind.

It does not envy, boast, or act in pride.

It does not dishonor others or seek its own interests.

It is not easily angered and keeps no record of wrongs.

It does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth.

It always protects, trusts, hopes, and perseveres.
